Session meets regularly at least once a month. We try to be pro-active but when you have a concern, please speak to a member of Session to have it addressed. Long-time elder Lois L. is at present on leave from Session. Currently, we are updating required Police Checks and Covenant of Care forms from elders, Sunday School teachers and others who meet with the vulnerable.

The church directory has been updated (June 2025) and is available in the office.

The **Living Table** continues most Fridays, and we hope you'll take the opportunity to bring friends and family to share in this informal gathering.



We need volunteers to help with Sunday morning coffee and organizing funeral and memorial teas. If you could help with this, please give your name to the office, or speak with an elder.

Calvin received a grant from Presbytery to create a **Summer Music Camp for Children and Youth**. The team continues to work on promoting this opportunity. Reverend Kim and our representative elder attend regular **Presbytery** meetings so we can keep up to date on current church events and keep informed of available grants. Calvin will host Presbytery's annual dinner meeting 2026 next June. Recently we were able to secure support for our hosting of the **Temporary Foreign Workers** gathering and will welcome them again on August 24th and October 26th. You're welcome to come to meet them so check the Bulletin for times. Thanks to Jonathan S. for his help with this Outreach mission.

The **Ghana Mission Team** reported their successful trip, and we continue to keep in touch with the church there, hoping to be able to help them get a keyboard for their Sunday services.

In the past few months, we've had a couple of **non-budget expenses** with the needed replacement of the window in the "steeple", the water pipe breakage in the Montessori School area (of which their prompt attention and reporting helped Andy K. to curtail further damage), and the

breakdown of the commercial freezer in the kitchen. It's always something, even with God watching over us!



THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

THE APOSTLES' CREED

*please stand in body or in spirit

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church*, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen

* with a small "c", "catholic Church", refers to the universal Christian Church - all believers in Jesus Christ.

THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

Leader: The Lord be with you

ALL: and also with you

Leader: Lift up your hearts,

ALL: we lift them to the Lord

Leader: Let us give thinks to the Lord our God

ALL: It is right to give God thanks and praise.

Leader:

Holy God, Creator of heaven and earth, with joy we give you thanks and praise. You call your people to repentance, to renew their covenant with you and to prepare for the joyful victory feast of the Lord. Therefore, with all your faithful people we join with the whole creation to lift our hearts in joyful praise.

(ALL) Holy, Holy, Holy Lord,
God of Power and Might,
Heaven and earth are full of your Glory.
Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord
Hosanna in the highest.

Leader:

We praise you, most holy God, for sending your only Son Jesus to live among us. He took up his cross and died that we might live. We praise you that he overcame death and is risen.

Remembering our Lord's command to take and eat, we ponder the mystery of his promise that in this meal we are joined to him, and to one another as a holy people.

Today we gather at his invitation to break bread and share the cup and to proclaim the mystery of our faith:

(ALL)

Christ has died; Christ is risen; Christ will come again.

Leader:

Gracious God, pour out your Holy Spirit upon us and upon this bread and wine, that we, and all who share this feast, may be one with Christ and he with us. Here we offer ourselves to be a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to you.

Through Christ, in Christ in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honour is yours, almighty God forever and ever. **Amen**.

God will go with you each hour of every day.
Go now in faith, steadfast strong and true.
Know he will guide you in all you do.
Go now in love, and show you believe.
