# CALVIN MUSIC ACADEMY

Calvin Music Academy is dedicated to fostering a lifelong love of music in students of all ages. Our experienced instructors provide instruction encouraging creativity musicality and having fun playing in a group setting.

The academy offers a diverse range of programs from beginner and intermediate <u>VIOLIN</u> classes for children 8-12 years to intermediate classes for children 9-15 years.

There is also beginner **GUITAR** and **UKULELE** classes for adults as well as drop guitar and ukulele sessions for those who just want to play songs with a group. No music reading is necessary.

The lessons are an hour in length and run for 12 weeks. The beginner lessons will feed into the next level of lessons which will begin in January 2026. The cost is \$120.00 for 12 classes; that's \$10.00 per class!!

#### **SUMMER 2025 NOTES FROM SESSION**

Session meets regularly at least once a month. We try to be pro-active but when you have a concern, please speak to a member of Session to have it addressed. Long-time elder Lois L. is at present on leave from Session. Currently, we are updating required Police Checks and Covenant of Care forms from elders, Sunday School teachers and others who meet with the vulnerable.

The church directory has been updated (June 2025) and is available in the office.

The **Living Table** continues most Fridays, and we hope you'll take the opportunity to bring friends and family to share in this informal gathering.



We need volunteers to help with Sunday morning coffee and organizing funeral and memorial teas. If you could help with this, please give your name to the office, or speak with an elder.

Calvin received a grant from Presbytery to create a **Summer Music Camp for Children and Youth**. The team continues to work on promoting this opportunity. Reverend Kim and our representative elder attend regular **Presbytery** meetings so we can keep up to date on current church events and keep informed of available grants. Calvin will host Presbytery's annual dinner meeting 2026 next June. Recently we were able to secure support for our hosting of the **Temporary Foreign Workers** gathering and will welcome them again on August 24<sup>th</sup> and October 26<sup>th</sup>. You're welcome to come to meet them so check the Bulletin for times. Thanks to Jonathan S. for his help with this Outreach mission.

The **Ghana Mission Team** reported their successful trip, and we continue to keep in touch with the church there, hoping to be able to help them get a keyboard for their Sunday services.

In the past few months, we've had a couple of **non-budget expenses** with the needed replacement of the window in the "steeple", the water pipe breakage in the Montessori School area (of which their prompt attention and reporting helped Andy K. to curtail further damage), and the

breakdown of the commercial freezer in the kitchen. It's always something, even with God watching over us!

Reverend Kim has been appointed as **Interim Moderator** to St. John's Presbyterian Church in White Rock. As well, he will be on **Sabbatical** from September through November and has arranged for a variety of visiting ministers and elders to lead us in worship on Sundays.

Volunteers are always welcome to help with our church maintenance and activities.
