# THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

## \*THE APOSTLES' CREED

\*please stand in body or in spirit

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church\*, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen

\* with a small "c", "catholic Church", refers to the universal Christian Church - all believers in Jesus Christ.

#### THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

Leader: The Lord be with you and also with you Lift up your hearts,

ALL: we lift them to the Lord

Leader: Let us give thinks to the Lord our God

ALL: It is right to give God thanks and praise.

Leader: It is truly right to glorify you, Father and to give you thanks, for you alone are God, living and true, dwelling in light inaccessible from before time and forever. Fountain of all life and source of all goodness, you made all things and fill them with your blessing, you created them to rejoice in the splendor of your radiance. With joyful hearts, and with grateful praise we say with one voice:

(ALL) Holy, Holy, Holy Lord, God of Power and Might, Heaven and earth are full of your Glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord Hosanna in the highest.

#### Leader:

Almighty God, you loved the world so much that in the fullness of time you sent your only Son to be our Saviour. He lived as one of us, yet without sin. To fulfill your purpose, he gave himself up to death; and, rising from the grave, destroyed death and made the whole creation new. We now celebrate this memorial of our redemption and proclaim our faith.

(ALL): Christ has died; Christ is risen; Christ will come again.

#### Leader:

Lord, we pray that in your goodness and mercy your Holy Spirit may descend upon us, and upon these gifts of bread and wine, sanctify them and showing them to be holy gifts for your holy people, the bread of life and the cup of salvation. Grant that all who share this bread and this cup may become one body and one spirit, a living sacrifice in Christ, to the praise of your name. Through Christ and with Christ, and in Christ, all honour and glory are yours, almighty God, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, forever. **Amen.**
