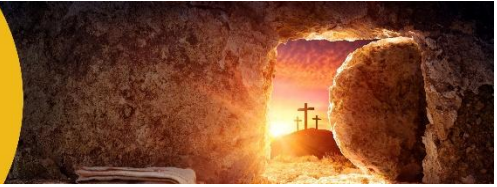

REBUILDING MEN'S LIVES DAILY

Empowering men to overcome addiction through faith, community and personal growth.

Joshua House is a faith-based program for men suffering from drug and alcohol addictions by offering each person a new start in life through our residential recovery program. We are a Christian, non-profit charitable organization that manages multiple recovery properties between Chilliwack and Abbotsford with a transitional program of care.

Among the core elements at Joshua House, recovery is built on connection and growth. Our program brings together peer groups, individual counseling, community living, spiritual reflection, and the 12 Steps. Each part strengthens the others, helping men find stability, purpose, and resilience for life beyond addiction. For those who need extra support, our After-Care Phase offers transitional housing and ongoing mentorship.
